If you are interested in legally adopting your foster cat, please email catnapvet@yahoo.com or ask about it in your messenger chat to learn about next steps. If you have friends or acquaintances that are interested in adopting your foster cat, please have them email catnapvet@yahoo.com with the subject "Adoption Application for 'Cat's Name'". Please have them state that they would like a copy of the adoption application to fill out and submit for adoption of your foster cat. It is important to note both the foster cat's name as well as your name because there may be more than one cat with the same name in the rescue. If a friend emails for an adoption application, please also let us know in the messenger chat so we don't miss the application. **Under no circumstances are you allowed to rehome the cat yourself and doing so constitutes theft. A cat is the property of Catnap from the Heart until an adoption application has been approved and an adoption fee has been paid to them. Only after approval from Catnap from the Heart may a cat be turned over to an approved adopter.**
